**ORDER: DFPEI 2012-08**

**EFFECTIVE: 1 November 2012**

Under the Natural Products Marketing Act, R.S.P.E.I.1988, Cap. N-3, and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations thereunder, Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

**SOLIDS NOT FAT PAYMENT LIMIT ORDER**

Application

1. This Order provides for the establishment of a limit on the amount of solids not fat in milk for which a producer will be paid.

Definitions

2. The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the *Prince Edward Island Natural Products Marketing Act* and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations.

Payment Limit

3. Payments for solids not fat delivered by a milk producer in each calendar month shall be limited to a maximum number of kilograms of protein and other solids represented by two and thirty-five one hundredths (2.35) multiplied by the producer's kilograms of butterfat production delivered in the same calendar month.

Application of Payment

4. Any funds retained as a result of producers exceeding the limit stated in Section 3 shall be paid pro-rata based on butterfat production to those producers who have marketed milk containing solids not fat less than or equal to two and thirty-five one hundredths (2.35) times the number of kilograms of butterfat produced that month.

Revocation

5. Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Order DFPEI 2005-08, is hereby revoked.

Commencement

6. This Order comes into force 1 November 2012.
