

CANADIAN DAIRY COMMISSION ACT
DAIRY PRODUCTS MARKETING REGULATIONS
PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND LEVY ORDER NO. 1

Application

1. The levies fixed and imposed by this order apply to persons engaged in the production for marketing, or the marketing of any dairy product in interprovincial or export trade that is, or is made from, milk or cream, or any component thereof, produced in Prince Edward Island.

Definitions

2.
 - (a) "Board" means the Prince Edward Island Milk Marketing Board constituted under the Natural Products Marketing Act, R.S.P.E.I. 1988 Cap. N-3;
 - (b) "Commission" means the Canadian Dairy Commission constituted by the Canadian Dairy Commission Act;
 - (c) "cream" does not include cream from cows for consumer use in liquid form;
 - (d) "dairy product" means milk, cream, butter, cheese, condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, dry milk, ice cream, malted milk or any other product manufactured wholly or mainly from milk, and includes sherbet;
 - (e) "federal quota" means the quantity of milk or cream, including any component thereof, allotted by the Board to a producer pursuant to the Dairy Products Marketing Regulations;
 - (f) "marketing" includes selling, reselling, offering for sale, buying, pricing, assembling, packing, handling, storing, delivering or transporting.
3. Except as inconsistent with section 2, the words herein shall have the meanings as found in the Natural Products Marketing Act and the Prince Edward Island Milk Marketing Regulations.

Producer Levies


4. Levies are fixed and imposed on each producer as follows:
 - (a) \$0.785 per kilogram of butterfat or all milk delivered within the producer's federal quota;


- (b) \$0.095 per kilogram of butterfat on all farm separated cream delivered within the producer's federal quota;
- (c) \$9.375 per kilogram of butterfat on all milk delivered in excess of the producer's federal quota, or delivered without federal quota;
- (d) \$5.315 per kilogram of butterfat on all farm separated cream delivered in excess of the producer's federal quota, or delivered without federal quota.

Other Levies

- 5. Levies are fixed and imposed on any person marketing any dairy product in interprovincial or export trade that is, or is made from, milk or cream, or any component thereof, produced in Prince Edward Island by a producer without federal quota as follows:
 - (a) \$9.375 per kilogram of butterfat on all milk marketed;
 - (b) \$5.315 per kilogram of butterfat on all farm separated cream marketed;
 - (c) \$9.375 per kilogram of butterfat on all milk, and \$5.315 per kilogram of butterfat on all farm separated cream used in any dairy product marketed, other than milk or cream.
 - 6. The Commission hereby appoints the Board as its agent for the purpose of collecting the levies under this Order.
 - 7. This Order is made this 23 day of June, 1994, and is effective on that date.
