ATTENTION PEI AGRICULTURE PRODUCERS!

Looking ahead with the winter season approaching...it could be a good time to focus on your personal development. To finally take that bookkeeping course, driver training course, or any eligible hands-on, skill-focused training event that is specific to your learning requirements. You could be eligible for 50% funding to a maximum of \$2,000/year for skills training under the Business Development Program, and 50% funding to a maximum of \$1,000 over the life of CAP (2018-2023) for eligible software required for approved training.

All you need to do is find the training event you're interested in and submit a course description and quote for expenses with your completed training application form either by email to businessdevelopment@gov.pe.ca or regular mail:
