EFFECTIVE: 1 August 2012

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I.1988, Cap. N-3, and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations thereunder, Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

DAIRY PLANT LICENSING ORDER

Application	1.	This order provides for licensing of dairy plants.		
Definitions	2.	The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the <i>Natural Products Marketing Act</i> , R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap N-3, the <i>Natural Products Marketing Act</i> Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations thereunder, unless otherwise defined herein:		
CFIA		(a)	"CFIA" means the Canadian Food Inspection Agency;	
dairy plant		(b)	"dairy plant" means a premises, building or structure, where milk is received and dairy processing is conducted;	
dairy plant license		(c)	"dairy plant license" means a license issued by DFPEI under the terms of this order;	

- (d) "DFPEI" means Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island;
- (e) "fluid milk product", also called "class 1 milk product" means any product made from milk or cream that is prepared for sale in liquid or fluid form;
- (f) "industrial milk product" means any product processed or derived in whole or in part from milk that is not a fluid milk product and includes butter, cheese, evaporated milk, concentrated milk, condensed milk, cultured products, milk powder, ice cream, casein and other products designated as industrial milk products;
- (g) "milk" means the normal milk from cows;

- (h) "processing" means heating, pasteurizing, sterilizing, evaporating, drying, churning with other substances by any process, or otherwise treating milk in the manufacture or preparation of milk products and for clarity, includes any reworking, reprocessing or repackaging of previously manufactured dairy products.; and
- (i) "processor" means a person performing any processing of milk.

3. No person shall conduct business of processing milk in Prince Edward Island unless they possess a dairy plant license from Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island.

Requirement for license

4. (1) A person intending to commence business as a milk processor or seeking to amend the terms of an existing license shall apply to Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward using the forms specified under section 7 of this order.

Application and terms of license

- (2) The licenses specified in section 3 may be made subject to any terms and conditions the Board considers appropriate.
- (3) Licenses granted under this order are specific to the dairy plant and products listed with the license and do not authorize the licensee to perform other processing activities at the licensed dairy plant. Licenses shall designate dairy plants as processors of fluid milk products, industrial milk products or both.
- 5. A licensed dairy plant which complies with the provisions of this Order and all other applicable regulations, and continues to do so, shall be entitled to renew their license upon submission of an application to renew and payment of the appropriate fee.

Renewal of license

6. (1) The application fee for a dairy plant license shall be fifty dollars.

Fees

- (2) The renewal fee for a dairy plant license in which there are no changes from the previous application shall be twenty-five dollars.
- 7. (1) New applications and applications to amend the terms or conditions of a license, including amendment to the list of products to be manufactured at a dairy plant, shall be made using the form set out in Schedule 1 to this order and shall include all documentation listed on that form.

Form of application

- (2) Applications for renewal that do not include any changes to a license shall be made using the form set out in Schedule 2 to this order, and shall include all documentation listed on that form.
- 8. All licenses shall be issued by the Board in a format consistent with the form set out in Schedule 3 to this order and shall be accompanied by a list of the products the licensee is authorized to process at the facility.

Form of license

9. All dairy plant licenses issued by Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island shall expire annually on 31 October, or as otherwise specified in the conditions of the license.

Expiration

- 10. The Board shall not:
 - (1) issue a license pursuant to this Order; or
 - (2) approve any term or condition of a license issued pursuant to this order unless, in the opinion of the Board:

Requirement to apply license in best interest of public or dairy trade

- (a) issuing a license or approving a term or condition of a license is in the best interest of the general public or the dairy products trade; and
- (b) the applicant has demonstrated the ability to meet all regulatory, health and safety requirements for processing.

Transfer prohibited

11. Licenses issued under these regulations are not transferable.

Proof of inspection required

12. Proof of inspection of the dairy plant, in the form of a valid license issued under the PEI Public Health Act, Milk Processing Regulations, or a valid registration granted by CFIA under the Canada Agricultural Products Act, Dairy Products Regulations, is a requirement for holding a dairy plant license. Cancellation, expiration, revocation or suspension of such proof of inspection shall be cause for immediate suspension of a dairy plant license.

Revocation or Suspension of License 13.

The Board may suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew a license for failure to provide or perform the licensed service or, for failure to observe, perform or carry out the provisions of any governing act, regulations, orders or any condition specified in a license issued under this order.

Commencement

14. This Order comes into force on the 1st day of August 2012.
