DFPEI 2012-01 DAIRY FARMERS OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

ORDER: DFPEI 2012-01

EFFECTIVE: 1 August 2012

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I.1988, Cap. N-3, and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations thereunder, Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

FLUID MILK DISTRIBUTOR LICENSING ORDER

Application

1. This order provides for licensing distributors of fluid milk products.

Definitions

- 2. The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap N-3, the *Natural Products Marketing Act* Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations thereunder, unless otherwise defined herein:
 - a) "distributor" means a person engaged in selling or distributing fluid milk products directly or indirectly to consumers, and for better certainty includes a processor, but does not include a storekeeper;
 - b) "distributor license" means a license issued by DFPEI under the terms of this order;
 - c) "DFPEI" means Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island;
 - d) "fluid milk product", also called "class 1 milk product" means any product made from milk or cream that is prepared for sale in liquid or fluid form;
 - e) "milk" means the normal milk from cows; and
 - f) "storekeeper" means any person who carries on a retail grocery business and includes wholesale and discount food stores.

Requirement

for License

3. No person shall conduct business as a distributor of fluid milk products in Prince Edward Island unless they possess a distributor's license from Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island.

Application and Terms of

License

- 4. (1) A person intending to commence business as a distributor of fluid milk products or seeking to amend the terms of an existing license shall apply to Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward using the forms specified under section 7 of this order.
 - (2) The licenses specified in section 3 may be made subject to any terms and conditions the Board considers appropriate.

(3) Licenses granted under this order are specific to the products listed with the license and do not authorize the licensee to distribute other fluid milk products.

Renewal of License

5. A licensed distributor who complies with the provisions of this Order and all other applicable regulations, and continues to do so, shall be entitled to renew their license upon submission of an application to renew and payment of the appropriate fee.

- Fees 6.
- (1) The application fee for a distributor's license shall be fifty dollars.
- (2) The renewal fee for a distributor's license in which there are no changes from the previous application shall be twenty-five dollars.

Form of Application

- 7. (1) New applications and applications to amend the terms or conditions of a license, including amendment to the list of licensed products, shall be made using the form set out in Schedule 1 to this order and shall include all documentation listed on that form.
 - (2) Applications for renewal that do not include any changes for a license shall be made using the form set out in Schedule 2 to this order and shall include all documentation listed on that form.

Form of License

- 8. All licenses shall be issued by the Board in a format consistent with the form set out in the Schedule 3 to this order and shall be accompanied by a list of the products the licensee is authorized to distribute.
- Expiration 9. All licenses issued by Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island shall expire annually on 31 July or as otherwise specified in the conditions of the license.

Requirement to Apply License in Best Interest of Public or

Dairy Trade 10. The Board shall not:

- (1) issue a license pursuant to this Order; or
- (2) approve any term or condition of a license issued pursuant to this order unless, in the opinion of the Board:
 - (a) issuing a license or approving a term or condition of a license is in the best interest of the general public or the dairy products trade; and
 - (b) the applicant has demonstrated the ability to meet all regulatory, health and safety requirements for distribution of Class 1 milk products.

Transfer Prohibited

11. Licenses issued under these regulations are not transferable.

Generic Product

Distribution 12.

All fluid milk products not carrying the registered trademark of the manufacturer must be distributed by a licensed PEI fluid milk distributor.

Revocation or Suspension of

License

13. The Board may suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew a license for failure to provide or perform the licensed service or, for failure to observe, perform or carry out the provisions of any governing act, regulations, orders or any condition specified in a license issued under this order.

Transition

Date

- 14. All licenses issued under DFPEI Order 2011-04 shall remain in effect under this Order until they are renewed, expire or are revoked.
- 15. DFPEI shall not accept new applications under this Order until the 1st of October 2012.
- Revocation 16. DFPEI Order 2011-04 dated 7 March 2011 is hereby revoked.

Commencement

17. This Order comes into force on the 1st day of August 2012.
